On **10th March, 2021 starting at 7.30 pm** we are conducting the first of a series of education seminars in relation to The Gap Sustainability Initiative.

Our presenter for the evening will be Mr Stuart Richards.

Stuart will be conducting a 20 minute presentation **on energy**, and in particular:-

- Understanding your power bill
- What can be done to reduce waste
- What can be done to reduce expense
- How to use and value energy
- What data you may have available and how to use it.

If you have your power bill, it may be useful for you to bring it to the information session so you can follow details in relation to reading and understanding that bill. Equally, if you have data on your smart meter (if you have one), that might be useful to bring.

On **14th April, 2021, 7.30 pm** we will be conducting a further education session.

Our presenter for the evening will be Mr Alexander Stathakis.

He will be providing an introduction to carbon footprints.

- What is a carbon footprint?
- How does it help us to understand our impact on the environment?
- What does carbon neutral mean and how is it different to net zero emissions?
- Buying more eco-friendly – understanding the carbon footprint of a product;
- How to reduce your carbon footprint.

The May education forum, on 12th May, 2021 will bring you an invited guest from another community to provide feedback on their community experiences, initiatives what they have done and what lessons they have learned.
