Where can I recycle?

The [Keperra refuse tip](#) takes many recyclable and treasure trove items:

Recycle	Treasure
aluminium cans batteries (domestic quantities only of household batteries including AAA and D batteries, and lead acid batteries such as car batteries) cardboard and paper clean polystyrene (up to five cubic metres. Loads more than five cubic metres attract fees and charges) toys (Note: broken plastic toys can be recycled in the hard plastic bin. For toys in good condition, refer to acceptable Treasure Trove items) electronic waste* empty gas bottles (a maximum of up to six, nine-kilogram gas bottles) fire extinguishers fluorescent lighting tubes and bulbs glass bottles and jars metals (both ferrous and non-ferrous) mobile phones oil - used mineral engine oil (100 litre limit) oil – cooking oil (20 litre limit) paint, water or oil-based paint (100 litre limit) white goods and appliances.	artwork antiques and sculptures books clothing - quality textiles and wearable clothing furniture and other household items in good working order kitchen utensils shoes and bags sporting equipment including bikes and exercise equipment toys - good quality only (broken plastic toys must be recycled in the hard plastic bin).
